Sainted Spires and Silken Strongholds in Valencia

Steeped in tradition, inundated in head-spinning architecture and drenched in history spanning more than 2,000 years, Valencia leaves you breathless. The labyrinthine streets of Ciutat Vella thread between cobbled plazas where flaming festivals erupt throughout the year. Spectacular frescoes, Gothic towers and intricately carved stonework make the city's religious buildings some of the most awe-inspiring in the world, while secular strongholds like La Lonja — the UNESCO-listed Silk Exchange — echo its history as a commercial powerhouse. At the heart of it all, the Mercado Central, an Art Nouveau temple of gastronomy where generations of traders have fed the city under the iconic black and white roof for 100 years.

4 Coquettish Casablanca

Like a lighthouse, the majestic Hassan II Mosque beckons us to the shores of this bustling port city, its minaret soaring 690ft to the sky. Africa's biggest mosque is one of only two in Morocco open to non-Muslims, inviting us to marvel its mosaics, marble columns and 50 Murano glass chandeliers. Casablanca conjures a charismatic collision of tradition and modernity, the Habous Quartier's faded grandeur of French colonial Art Deco, whitewashed Moorish houses, narrow alleyways, small souks and olive markets in companion to its cosmopolitan nightlife, buzzing restaurants and Parisien-style cafes.

5 The Phoenix of Agadir

Sun, sea, and atmospheric architecture are in abundance in Agadir, a buzzy coastal oasis nicknamed the 'Miami of Morocco'. Stroll into a 1,000 years of memories along modern, tree-lined boulevards designed by Le Corbusier after an earthquake levelled much of the city in 1960. Like a phoenix, Agadir arose and arouses travellers seeking a tapestry of treasures. Meander the Marina to eat fresh fish by the harbour, stroll the beach-side promenade then cool off under the trees in the Valley of the Birds. Shop Souk El Had, with nearly 6,000 stalls laden with spices, tajines, and teapots, then climb the Kasbah of Agadir Oufella, where history lives amongst massive rammed earth walls.

6 Natural & Manmade Artistry in Arrecife

Artist César Manrique put little Arrecife on the map. Explore his eclectic works in underground caverns, fabulous murals and his former home in nearby Tahíche, or sate your artistic appetite in contemporary gallery MIAC and the surreal underwater world of sculptor Jason deCaires Taylor. The spectral landscape of Timanfaya, once a seething sea of lava shattered by volcanic eruptions, is ripe for 4x4 exploration, while the year-round waves of Playa de Famara invite beginners and pros alike to grab a surfboard and take the plunge.

Jewel of the Canary Islands

Drop a sun-kissed Spanish city onto an island off the coast of North Africa, add a sprinkle of tropical charm and place an active volcano on the doorstep and you have Santa Cruz de Tenerife. Feast on tantalising tapas before exploring neighbouring San Cristóbal de la Laguna's UNESCO-listed Old Town, whose ancient doorways conceal exquisitely tiled courtyards and hand-carved balconies overlooking resplendent churches. Beyond, Tenerife is dotted with half-moon bays, immaculate golf courses, vineyard-covered hillsides, labyrinthine lava tunnels and sheer basalt cliffs: a primordial landscape sculpted by the fury of mighty Mount Teide.

Descend at speed in a wicker sleigh piloted by 'Carreriros' elegantly dressed in crisp whites and straw boater hats since the mid-1800s. Swirl a glass of amber-coloured Madeira at a café overlooking chequerboard-tiled Praça do Município and prepare to explore lush cloud forests crisscrossed by hiking trails and black sand beaches below jungle-covered cliffs.

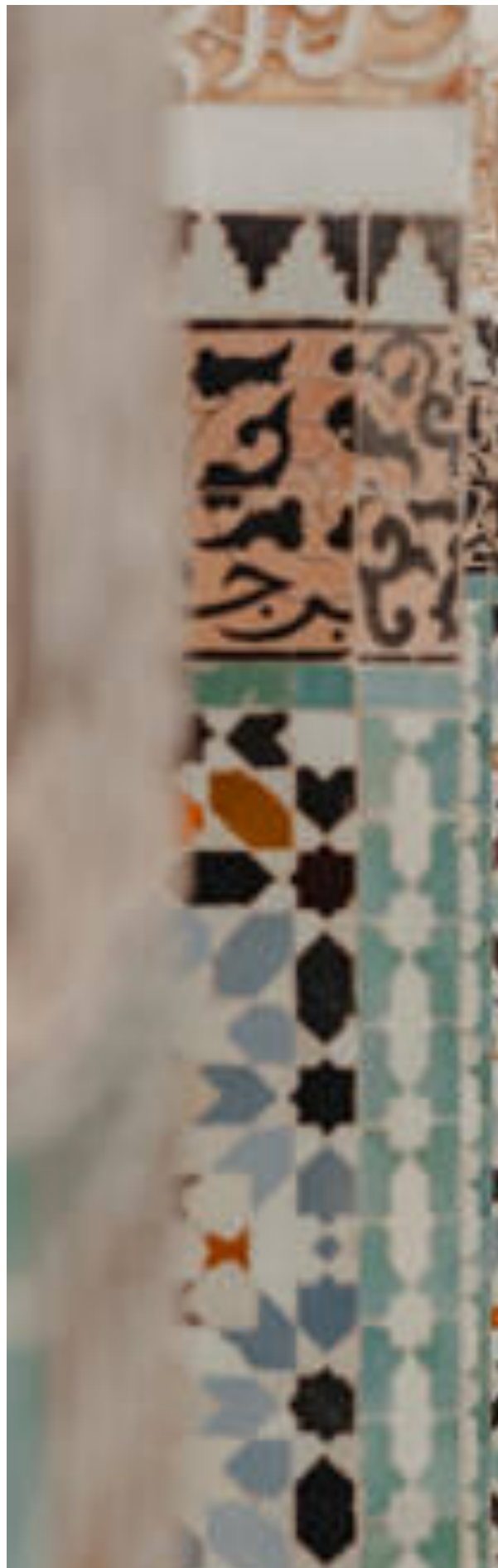
Day 1

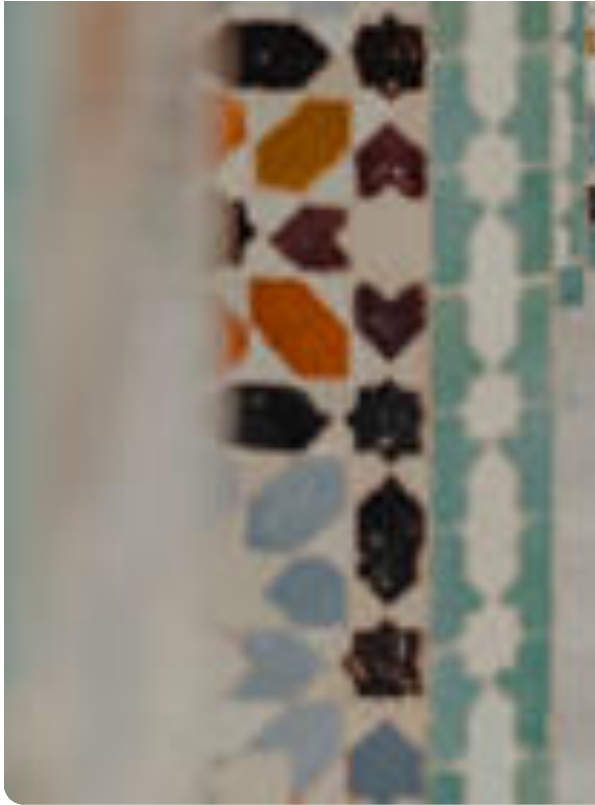
Day 2

Its treasures are around 150 richly decorated pieces of *mashrabiyaas*, marble, carvings and paintings on beech and cedar, stucco, *zellige* tiles, the Maghreb's first stained-glass windows, and many green spaces abundant with orange, banana, cypress, hibiscus and jasmine trees.

We'll continue to the revered Ben Youssef Medersa, an architectural treasure nestled in the heart of the ancient Medina. The largest, most important Islamic college in Morocco, the *medersa* was built in 1565 and for four centuries welcomed students eager for and remained for four centuries a bastion for scholars, a goal and a destination for students keen to expand their knowledge, especially in religious disciplines. See its magnificent interior patio, and catch a glimpse of dormitory life for the students who lived and learned within its walls.

You'll then have free time on your own to explore once again the attraction of Djemaa el-Fna's hard-to-resist offerings. Appetites awakened, we'll walk to enjoy a relaxing lunch that lets you explore the tastes typically found in local kitchens.

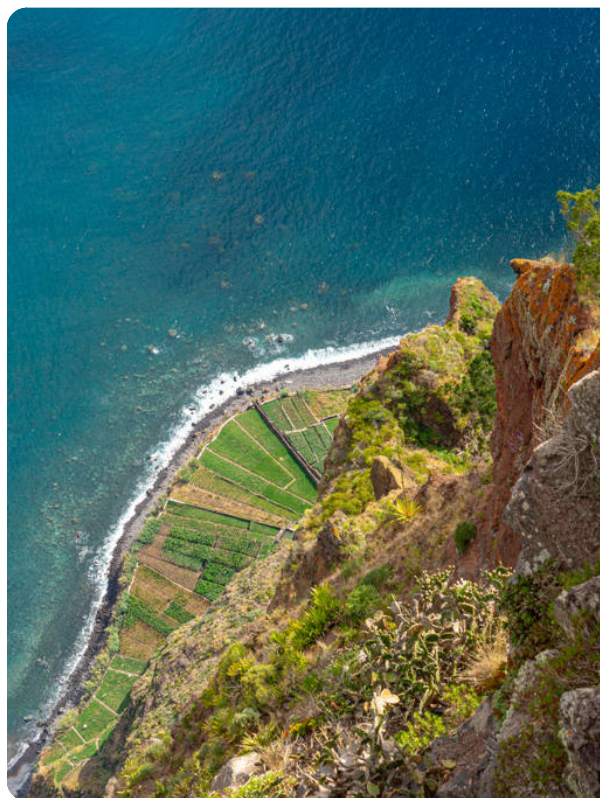

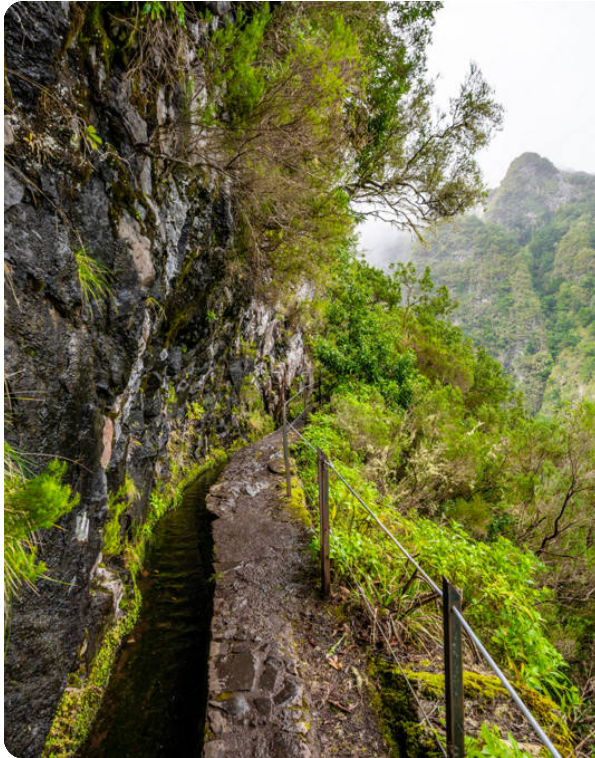
